

1. Cut out the sheet so you have this (if your printer doesn't aline perfectly hold the sheet up to the light or a window and make sure you are not cutting of f any of the text.



2. Fold along these (red) lines

3. Glue the blue section down into your book



4. Folded it should look like this.

5. Open one flap - eg CaCO3, follow the arrow to see what happens when you add water by lifting the next flap.

6. I then use these in lessons by going straight into exam question practice having the pupils 'discover the answer by lifting the appropriate flap.
